Requirements and Conditions

1. I have read and understood the different levels and requirements of the Award program set out in the Program Requirements (attached to this form).
2. I understand every Award Agent has the discretion to accept or reject participants and proposed activities to be undertaken as part of the Award program.
3. I understand the Award Agent will seek parental or guardian consent for my participation in the Award program.
4. I understand that I must be a participant prior to commencing activities in relation to the Award program. I understand I am not a participant until I am allocated a Participant Identification Number by Awards WA.
5. I understand that on being allocated a Participant Identification Number, I will receive a Record Book. I confirm I will read the requirements of the Award program contained in the Record Book prior to commencing activities in relation to the Award program. I understand Awards WA has the discretion to determine whether the Award program requirements have been met and therefore whether an Ignite Youth Award Level 1 – 4 should be issued.
6. I understand that Awards WA has limited personal accident and public liability insurance which commences on the date of issue of the Record Book.
7. I understand that certain activities in the Special Exclusions set out in the Insurance Schedule (available at awardswa.org.au) are not covered by the insurance. I understand that:
 - The Award Agent may decide not to approve a proposed activity if it involves an activity that is not covered by the insurance, or may approve such an activity only when I produce evidence of other acceptable insurance; and
 - If I choose to participate in activities that are not insured, my participation in these activities is at my own risk.
8. If I accept transport in a vehicle driven, ridden, flown, sailed etc by someone else who is not an Involved Person, I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure:
 - That the vehicle is roadworthy (or the equivalent for other types of transport) and insured for personal injury; and

Award Program Structure

The Ignite Award is a challenging program of discovery for young people aged 9 – 13 and provides a framework to learn valuable skills, assist others in the community and experience some adventures. It is a great tool for young people to transition into secondary school and fosters positive self development and leadership skills.

There are 4 levels of the Ignite Award:

- Levels 1 & 2
- Levels 3 & 4

To achieve any level of the Ignite Award, young people create a unique program of four activities: Physical Activity, Hobby, Volunteering and Adventure. Young people can complete the activities in a single session, however we encourage them to undertake their activities over a period of time.

Physical Activity

To encourage participation in physical activities and improvement in fitness and performance.

Hobby

To encourage the development of personal interests and practical skills.

Volunteering

To develop and encourage a sense of community spirit and responsibility to others.

Adventure

Encourage a spirit of adventure and increase confidence in unfamiliar places.

DEFINITIONS

Award program means Ignite Youth Award (Ignite Award)

Involved Person is anyone involved in award activities including Ignite Award Leaders, staff, volunteers and others who assist with Award program activities, but not including participants.

Award Agent means an organisation or person granted the provision by Awards WA to deliver the Award program in Western Australia.

Participant means a person between the ages of 9 – 13 who has been allocated a Participant Identification Number by Awards WA.

Participant Registration Fee means a fee set by Awards WA from time to time, payable by participants for registration in the Award program.

Person Information means information the participant gives to Awards WA about him or herself in connection with the Award program, either on this form or at any time in the future.

Record Book means a book provided to participants in which activities and Ignite Guide reports are recorded.
